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# 2010 Lock In for LIFE

Friday, December 3 (8pm) to Saturday, December 4 ( 8am)

Our Lock In is a fun activity to raise money for the March for Life trip. Students report to ST. JOHN (lower level) before 8pm. At that time we will lock the doors and NO ONE will enter or leave ( except the pizza delivery guy and parent chaperones). During the night, there will be NO SLEEPING. We will spend the night doing some fun activities while learning more about the reasons for our trip and the Catholic Church's teaching on all life issues.

**Students NOT going to Washington DC** may come to the Lock In. We ask that you pay \$20 to contribute to the trip (tax deductible). You may also collect pledges if you like.

Our goal is to raise at least \$100 per student. This seems like a lot- but if you get 10 people to each sponsor you for \$1 an hour, that puts you over the top! Be certain you thank all your sponsors- no matter the amount- every little bit helps!

## Rules

1. Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in when you get to the lock in. We will copy them and return them to you in the morning.**
2. Pledges may be made by anyone. **Please ask everyone who pledges if their company has a matching gift fund policy.**
3. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per hour, and maximum pledge.** Students may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.
4. At the lock in, all students will remain awake the ENTIRE night! We will have plenty to keep you busy. Parents may pick up students at 8am.
5. DO NOT BRING: pillow, blanket, iPod (or any music player), video games of any kind.
6. DO BRING: pledge form, a 2 liter of pop and large bag of chips/pretzels ( to share), comfy shoes or slippers, and a great attitude. Students MAY bring cell phones, BUT they need to be turned in to Mrs. Alderman.
7. We will record each student's hours on their pledge sheet and return it. Students may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with the money to Mrs. Alderman, Mrs Moritz or Mrs. Paton by Sunday December 12.**
8. We need adults to help! You can stay for the whole night or a few hours. You may be surprised how much you learn!
